#### SG CTA Index:

The SG CTA Index is an index published by Société Générale that is designed to reflect the performance of a pool of Commodity Trading Advisor (CTAs) selected from larger managers that employ systematic managed futures strategies. The index is reconstituted annually.


#### SG Trend Index:

The SG Trend Index is equal-weighted and reconstituted annually. The index calculates the net daily rate of return for a pool of trend following based hedge fund managers.

Morningstar Systematic Trend Category: Contains funds that primarily implement trend-following, price-momentum strategies by trading long and short liquid global futures, options, swaps, and foreign exchange contracts. The remaining exposure may be invested in a mix of other complementary non-traditional risk premia. These portfolios typically obtain exposure referencing a mix of diversified global markets, including commodities, currencies, government bonds, interest rates and equity indexes.



## Problem 1: 60/40 is Wobbly



- The volatility (annualized standard deviation) of a 60/40 portfolio is double what it was five years ago.
- Causes: Higher stock and bond volatility, plus flip to positive correlations.



### Problem 2: One Legged Stool




- Most diversifiers were designed to "bolster" either stocks or bonds, the proverbial "two-legged asset allocation stool."

What if you had a 20% allocation to DBMF since inception?




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# Could Replication = "Index-Plus"?



• DBMF has outperformed both the SGCTA hedge fund index and M\* US Fund Systematic Category since inception with a correlation of approximately 0.9.







## **Supplementary Definitions**



S&P GSCI: The S&P GSCI® is a composite index of commodity sector returns representing an unleveraged, long-only investment in commodity futures that is broadly diversified across the spectrum of commodities.

#### S&P MLP:

Morningstar LSTA US Leveraged Loan: The Morningstar LSTA US Leveraged Loan Index is designed to deliver comprehensive, precise coverage of the US leveraged loan market

PivotalPath Credit: The PivotalPath Credit Index is a performance composite of credit hedge funds.

PivotalPath Event Driven: The PivotalPath Event Driven Index is a performance composite of event driven hedge funds.

PivotalPath Equity Diversified: The PivotalPath Equity Diversified Index is a performance composite of Equity Diversified hedge funds.

S&P Private Equity: The S&P Listed Private Equity Index is designed to provide tradable exposure to the leading publicly-listed companies that are active in the private equity space.

MSCI US REIT: The MSCI US REIT Index is a free float-adjusted market capitalization weighted index that is comprised of equity Real Estate

Investment Trusts (REITs).

**DJ US Real Estate:** The index is designed to track the performance of real estate investment trusts (REIT) and other companies that invest directly or indirectly in real estate through development, management, or ownership, including property agencies.

**iBoxx High Yield:** The Markit iBoxx USD Liquid High Yield Index consists of liquid USD high yield bonds, selected to provide a balanced representation of the USD high yield corporate bond universe.

60% S&P / 40% AGG: 60% S&P / 40% AGG refers to an index that has invested 60% of assets in the S&P 500 Index and 40% of assets into the Bloomberg US Aggregate Index.

Gold: Gold futures are standardized, exchange-traded contracts in which the contract buyer agrees to take delivery, from the seller, a specific quantity of gold at a predetermined price on a future delivery date.

Bloomberg Euro Agg: The Bloomberg Euro Aggregate Bond Index includes fixed-rate, investment-grade Euro denominated bonds. Inclusion is based on the currency of the issue, and not the domicile of the issuer.

**S&P Euro-Bund:** The S&P Global Bond Futures Index series is a family of indices that seeks to track the performances of portfolios holding the nearest maturity bond futures contract. The S&P Euro-Bund Futures Index portfolio holds the nearest maturity Euro-Bund Futures contract.

Bloomberg TIPS: The Bloomberg US Treasury Inflation-Linked Bond Index (Series-L) measures the performance of the US Treasury Inflation Protected Securities (TIPS) market.

**Bloomberg MBS TR Index:** The Bloomberg Barclays US Mortgage Backed Securities (MBS) Index tracks fixed-rate agency mortgage backed passthrough securities guaranteed by Ginnie Mae (GNMA), Fannie Mae (FNMA), and Freddie Mac (FHLMC).

**iBoxx Investment Grade:** The Markit iBoxx USD Liquid Investment Grade Index is designed to reflect the performance of US Dollar (USD) denominated investment grade corporate debt. The index rules aim to offer a broad coverage of the USD investment grade liquid bond universe.

Volatility: Volatility is the degree of variation of a trading price series over time, usually measured by the standard deviation of logarithmic returns.
